The ABA Therapist Training program imparts the practical skills and theoretical knowledge required to work as an Applied Behaviour Analysis (ABA) therapist.

The ABA therapist's role is to teach play, communication, self-help and academic skills to children with an Autism Spectrum Disorder. This course focuses on developing and acquiring these skills, to work one-on-one with an ASD child. Students, parents, professionals, and educators have benefited greatly by understanding and applying ABA principles.
